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INTRODUCTION

To obtain a BSA licence you will need to satisfy each of the following licensing criteria:-

- § Technical Qualification;
- § Managerial Qualification (Trade licences only);
- § Experience in the scope of work for the licence class;
- § Financial Requirements.

This manual will assist you finding organisations which can assist with training and assessment services, to enable you to meet the technical criteria for a licence.

A formal technical qualification could consist of any of the following:-

- § A completed apprenticeship,
- § Successful completion of the appropriate course for the class of licence;
- § Successful completion of an equivalent course for the class of licence (eg similar modules);
- § A recognition certificate;
- § A qualification or statement of attainment of the required competency issued by an approved authority for the class of licence.

To determine which formal technical qualification will be required for a particular licence class, you should contact the BSA on 1300 272 272, or visit BSA's website at www.bsa.qld.gov.au.

If you do not hold a formal technical qualification, you may be eligible for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). The RPL process is a method by which an eligible applicant can obtain formal recognition of their current skills and knowledge, no matter how, when or where the learning occurred. Further information about RPL is provided in the next section of this manual (see Recognition of Prior Learning).

Should you have obtained your qualification overseas, you will need to have your qualification assessed against whether it is equivalent to the qualification required for the class of licence for which you are applying. For further information on assessment of overseas qualifications, refer to the next section of this manual (see Overseas Qualifications).

When you can provide evidence of your technical qualification and have met all other licensing criteria (listed above) you are ready to submit your application for a licence.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

It is common for people who hold a formal technical qualification to have gained this qualification through formal training. However, if you have not undertaken formal training with a course provider but have obtained your skills over a number of years under the supervision of others, you may be eligible to obtain a formal technical qualification through a process of Recognition of Prior Learning, also referred to as RPL or recognition of current competencies.

The RPL process is a method by which an eligible applicant can obtain formal recognition of their current skills and knowledge, no matter how, when or where the learning occurred, through a skills assessment.

RPL is a process of assessment conducted by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO). RTOs are either Government-run training colleges or privately-operated business enterprises. A fee will apply for the RPL process and depending on the type of qualification concerned, can sometimes be expensive. It is therefore recommended that you contact several RTOs and compare them on price before you commit to undergoing the RPL process with them.

The process usually involves an initial assessment of your eligibility for RPL. Bear in mind that the process can take several days to complete and the RTO will advise you on this. If eligible, an assessment of your skills and knowledge will be undertaken.

Where it is found there are gaps in your skills and knowledge, it may be recommended that you undertake gap training before being assessed for the full qualification. You might be offered gap training with the RTO that is conducting your RPL, or you may be referred to another RTO for formal training and assessment.

Construction Skills Queensland may be able to assist you with finding an RTO who can provide you with an RPL assessment – refer below to the section on 'Be Constructive', for contact details. The benefit of contacting Construction Skills Queensland is that you may be eligible for government assistance with funding for your assessment.



BE CONSTRUCTIVE - CONSTRUCTION SKILLS QUEENSLAND

Construction Skills Queensland is an independent industry-funded body supporting career seekers, apprentices, workers and employers in the building and construction industry. The organisation provides the construction industry with support, information, advice and funding assistance. They can provide information about training programs that will assist people interested in a trade to gain the necessary skills and experience in order to eventually be eligible to apply for a BSA licence.

Alternatively you may wish to seek the services of an RTO directly and can do so by referring to the 'List of Licence Classes' section of this booklet, finding the licence you are interested in and contacting the RTOs which are indicated to be providing services in the qualification for that licence class.

While this manual provides a list of RTOs to contact, it should be noted that is not a comprehensive list and a RTOs registration to deliver training and assessment for a particular qualification may change without notification to BSA.

For further information and current registration status of RTOs, refer to the Australian Government website, www.training.gov.au. This website contains a searchable database of Vocational Education and Training in Australia and can enable you to obtain a list of RTO's that are registered by scope, to deliver training and assessment in the qualification you may be seeking.

OVERSEAS QUALIFICATIONS

The technical qualifications for BSA licence classes are Australian nationally-recognised qualifications or accredited courses issued by Vocational Education organisations, or qualifications issued by Australian Tertiary institutions (universities etc).

This system is referred to as the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) and ranges from Level 1 through to Level 11 as illustrated below.

Vocational Education Training (VET) sector organisations are typically Registered Training Organisations which are technical colleges, for example, Institutes of Technical and Further Education (TAFE), SkillsTech, or are privately-run registered training organisations. Several RTOs are listed in later pages of this booklet (see 'List of Licence Classes' section of this booklet).

Tertiary sector institutions are typically universities and other educational institutions which award qualifications in under-graduate (eg. Bachelor Degree or below) or post-graduate (eg. Graduate Certificate or above) programs.

Typically someone who has completed an apprenticeship in a trade in Australia would have achieved somewhere in the range of an AQF Certificate III outcome. While the qualifications framework in each overseas country differs and each person's case is different, understanding the AQF should give an overseas-qualified person some idea at what level their qualification might align with. To apply for a licence however, formal evidence of an AQF qualification is required by the BSA.

If you are already resident in Queensland and have overseas qualifications which you believe may align with an Australian qualification you could contact the Skills Recognition branch of the Department of Education and Training (DET) to see if you are eligible for this service - Phone: 1300 369 935 –they may be able to assist you with an assessment of comparability of the AQF level of your overseas qualification (this is a free service and only available to eligible Queensland residents). Note this is not a Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) assessment – it is a comparability assessment to assess what AQF level your overseas qualification aligns with. This service is optional and is not required for a BSA licence.

If you utilised the Skills Recognition Branch process, it will then be necessary to demonstrate the technical content of your overseas qualification is sufficient to meet the technical qualification or requirements for the BSA licence class that you intend to apply for. To do this you will need to undergo a Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) assessment conducted by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO). To understand more about the RPL process, refer to previous section of this booklet.

Note: Holders of a **NEW ZEALAND** licence may not need to undertake the following steps and may be able to apply to become licensed under Mutual Recognition. Information about Mutual Recognition can be found on the BSA website (www.bsa.qld.gov.au). Go to the page for 'Builders/Contractors' and click on 'Applying for a Licence' where you will find the option for 'Interstate (Mutual Recognition)', which also applies to New Zealand licence holders.

Persons who hold qualifications above AQF level III may be eligible to apply to BSA directly if you are a member of a certain professional organisation. In this case, it is essential that you can demonstrate the study undertaken to gain your qualification is relevant to the scope of work for the licence. If you are already residing in Australia and have obtained membership from an Australian professional institute or body, in certain circumstances evidence of your membership level with that institute or body may help support your application. Please check with BSA if you are eligible to apply.

For trade-qualified people who obtained their qualifications outside of Australia and who are still residing overseas, who believe that qualification may be comparable to the ranges of AQF levels 1 to 3, some options currently exist to have your qualifications assessed and recognised in your home country (if it appears on the list below). Note that this option only relates to those Australian trade occupations indicated below.

These assessment services are currently offered in the **United Kingdom, Ireland, India, Sri Lanka, South Africa** and the **Phillippines** only.

The contact details for each Assessment Body indicated below is provided at the end of this section. These Assessment Bodies will be able to provide you with information about your eligibility and the assessment process.

Please note that the Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) listed in this booklet are provided as a guide only and can be subject to change at any time. The BSA does however strive to ensure that the information contained is as accurate and up-to-date as possible and welcomes feedback from RTOs where information should be amended or updated. Prospective licence applicants should be aware that it is common that RTOs will notify the BSA that they are delivering a qualification which aligns with a licence class and wish to be included in this booklet, however, RTOs do not always notify the BSA when they have discontinued delivery of a qualification and therefore should be removed from this booklet.

Prospective licence applicants should also note that RTOs often choose to offer more than one type of delivery of training and assessment. For example, they could decide to deliver all modes (on-campus/face-to-face/lecture style of delivery, electronic/online/web delivery, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), or Upskilling/Gap training). Delivery could be via one mode only, or a combination of all and RTOs will often change their delivery modes depending on demand. The BSA therefore recommends that interested persons make their own enquiries to see if an RTO is delivering the qualification they seek, the cost, duration and the mode of delivery, in order to make the decision of which option suits them best.

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Prospective licence applicants should also note that RTOs often choose to offer more than one type of delivery of training and assessment. For example, they could decide to deliver all modes (on-campus/face-to-face/lecture style of delivery, electronic/online/web delivery, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), or Upskilling/Gap training). Delivery could be via one mode only, or a combination of all and RTOs will often change their delivery modes depending on demand. The BSA therefore recommends that interested persons make their own enquiries to see if an RTO is delivering the qualification they seek, the cost, duration and the mode of delivery, in order to make the decision of which option suits them best.
